
FINANCIAL PEACE UNIVERSITY The cost of everything keeps going up, and programs like Financial Peace are helping families counter rising costs by using their money wisely. Beginning January 8<sup>th</sup> at 5:45pm, Ashley Sulfaro will teach a 9-week Financial Peace University course. This is a program designed to help families manage their God-given financial resources to best care for their families and community. This is one of our class offerings in January for Faith, Family and Fun – join us for a meal (starting at 5pm) and, if you have children, let them enjoy our children's ministry study and activities (5:45p) while you take your own class. To make the Financial Peace program more affordable for families, Trinity has purchased 10 copies of the course at a reduced price (\$60; regular program cost is \$154).
