
BOARD OF DIRECTORS UPDATE Board president Jim Vallade shares the following: The Trinity Lutheran Board of Directors held its quarterly meeting on Tuesday, October 15. The preliminary unaudited year-to-date financial statements as of 9/30/24 were presented and reflected the following: Year-to-Date Revenues -\$995,413; Year-to-Date Expenses -\$667,384; Year-to-Date Surplus -\$328,029. The Board approved the annual audit. The Board approved Staff Tuition Fund grants and Staff Housing allowances. The Board approved the addition of a part-time custodial position. The Board discussed the ongoing policy and procedure review. The Board approved the agenda for the upcoming voters' meeting. The nominating committee recommended Tom Morgan as a new Board member. This is a replacement for Ashley Sulfaro who is retiring from the Board. Cathy Toburen and Don French agreed to continue serving on the Board. The congregation will be asked to approve these candidates at the upcoming voters' meeting.

REMODELING LOAN UPDATE After October's loan payment to First Merchants Bank, the balance on Trinity's loan is \$47,533. Of the \$403,760 pledged for debt elimination, \$115,625 remains outstanding.
