BOARD OF DIRECTORS UPDATE The Trinity Lutheran Board of Directors held its quarterly meeting on Wednesday, July 17. The preliminary unaudited year-to-date financial statements as of 6/30/24 were presented and reflected the following:

Year-to-Date Revenues: \$2,214,663 Year-to-Date Expenses: \$2,209,942 Year-to-Date Surplus: \$4,721

The Board will be approving the audit at its next quarterly meeting in October. The Board received the school review presentation from Cindy Lucas (past principal) and Tracey Hackbarth (current principal). Items presented included school enrollment and new hires for the upcoming school year, as well as student standardized test results. The Board discussed its on-going policy and procedure review as well as the current committee structure. The Board approved the creation of a position for Director of Advancement.

CHURCH EXTENSION FUND The annual report for the Michigan District Church Extension Fund (CEF) is on the information tables in the sanctuary. CEF exists to provide loans to congregations and ministries throughout the Michigan District in order to further work in God's Kingdom. These loans are made possible through investments into CEF by individuals and congregations. Currently, CEF is offering a fixed certificate that earns 4.75% annually.
